

Spiritual Care Team

The Team work as part of the Hospice Multi-Disciplinary Team.

Spiritual Care is an important part of the holistic care which is offered to patients, their carers, families and friends at The Hospice of The Good Shepherd.

Spiritual needs may not be the same as religious needs, you may wish to talk about how you are feeling, about the events that are happening to you or what's important to you at this time. Our Spiritual Care team are available to talk with you about anything you wish to talk about.

The Spiritual Care Team

We are a team of trained and supervised volunteers who offer pastoral support throughout the Hospice as requested. The Spiritual Care Co-ordinator is a member of the Association of Hospice and Palliative Care Chaplains and the team adheres to national standards for Hospices and Palliative Care Chaplaincy.

The team is here to offer you support and a listening ear. Your individual experiences, feelings and views will be respected whatever they may be.

The Team can also arrange visits by a leader from a patient's own faith community or religious tradition. We have an up to date contact list of those from faith or no faith organisations who are willing to support the work of the hospice, its patients and staff.

From the Christian Tradition we are able to offer Holy Communion and prayers at your bedside if you wish.



Services are held in the quiet room in response to daily needs. Personal requirements for services or to celebrate special events can be arranged in consultation with the Spiritual Care Co-ordinator.

An on-call member of the team is available at all times in consultation with The Spiritual Care Co-ordinator or a member of Nursing staff on the In-Patient unit.

It is our aim to provide the spiritual resources you need to help at a difficult time.
