

# Hospice Ride Out

## Terms and Conditions 2022

### General

1. These booking terms and conditions apply to everyone who takes part in the Ride Out.
2. These terms and conditions contain important information regarding participation, and upon entry you agree to and accept these terms and conditions.
3. Photographs will be taken of participants throughout the event, these will be used on promotional materials. It is the participant's responsibility to let staff know at registration if you do not want to appear in any such materials.
4. There is a full risk assessment in place for this event. However, by taking part in this event, all participants acknowledge that there is a risk of illness or injury beyond the control of the organisers. Participants must also consider the safety of others.
5. Hospice of the Good Shepherd reserve the right to alter the start time of the event at any time.
6. Hospice of the Good Shepherd reserve the right to cancel this event at any time. In the unlikely event of this happening entry fees will be returned in full.
7. The entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Entry Rules for Ride Out

1. All riders must be road legal
2. All bikes must be road legal
3. All bikes must be insured and rider responsible for their own bikes. Although the Hospice has event insurance, in the event of an accident the participants involved must claim on their own insurance.
4. The event will be marshalled. Ensuring that participants follow the correct route and obey the road rules. The marshals are not responsible for any accidents. It is the responsibility of every rider to pay close attention to fellow road users.
5. The route will be given to each rider before the event, to help with familiarity and preparation including fuel levels.
6. All participants must abide by any rules, instructions and regulations displayed or given on the day of the event by Hospice of the Good Shepherd staff.
7. Hospice of the Good Shepherd shall not be liable for any injury, death, damage or loss howsoever suffered by riders

### On the Day

1. The Hospice Ride Out will start from Chester.
2. We ask that everyone is treated with respect and that no aggressive or abusive language or behaviour is used towards our organisers and volunteers
3. First Aid facilities will be provided at the event.

4. The first marshal will lead the bikes off at 10.30 along the route to the lunch venue
5. The route will be marshalled from start to finish
6. The ride out will finish at the Hospice of the Good Shepherd

### **Safety**

1. Children aged under 16 are welcome but must be accompanied by a person of 18 years of age or older who is a registered participant.
2. All participants are required to wear appropriate safety clothing including helmets. Any rider not deemed to be wearing appropriate clothing by organisers will not be permitted to participate in the event..
3. All minors must be accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for their safety throughout the event.
4. Disabled entrants are welcome to take part. Please contact the Hospice prior to booking to establish whether the event is suitable for you.

### **7. Data protection**

- a. The information you provide at registration will be shared only with that organisation, it will not be passed to or shared with any other organisation.
